

## **Wernhil 'Drive Your Festive Spirit' Competition Terms & Conditions**

### **1. General Information**

1. The competition is organised and hosted by Wernhil Park (Pty) Ltd ("Wernhil") (Company Registration Number: 1957/1071), representing the owners and tenants of Wernhil Shopping Centre. The competition will run from **8 October 2024 until 14 December 2024**. Entries submitted before **08:00 on 8 October 2024** or after **23:59 on 2 December 2024** will not be accepted.
2. All participants must be Namibian citizens or holders of a valid Namibian permit, aged eighteen (18) or older and must possess a valid driving license to be eligible to enter the competition to win the car. A valid identification document must be presented to Wernhil Management when selected as a potential winner.

### **2. Eligibility**

1. No O&L Directors, employees of BrandX, Broll Namibia, Wernhil Shopping Centre employees, Wernhil tenants, Wernhil tenant staff, service agents (including Omega Security, Lida Cleaning Service and Advance Parking Solutions), or their direct family members may participate in the competition.
2. Entries must be submitted directly by the individual participating in the competition. Only the person whose name and contact details appear on the entry will be eligible to win; no representatives or third-party entries will be permitted.

### **3. Entry Process**

1. To enter the competition, contestants must shop at any store located in Wernhil for a minimum of **N\$250.00**. Entrants must write their first and last name, as well as their mobile number, on the back of the receipt and drop it into one of the entry boxes located in the centre or in any of the Wernhil stores.
2. Multiple entries are permitted, provided that each receipt meets the **N\$250.00** minimum amount. Receipts from different stores may not be combined to meet this amount.
3. Entries are permitted every day, subject to being one (1) receipt per store per day.
4. Copies of receipts may be submitted for entry if the original is required as proof of purchase. This applies exclusively to clothing items and electrical appliances and must be stamped by a Wernhil promoter or staff with the official Wernhil Park (Pty) Ltd stamp. Failure to provide a stamped receipt will result in disqualification. The Wernhil Centre Management located on the upper retail level can assist with a stamped copy.

5. Free double entry: Participants who spend **N\$500.00** or more in a single transaction during the campaign period are eligible for an additional free entry. All extra entries will be documented on a separate entry form, stamped with the Wernhil Park (Pty) Ltd official stamp and submitted by the campaign management into the "Big Money Blower" located in the Wernhil Pick n Pay atrium.

#### 4. Final Draw Process

1. Final Draw Process: The 'Drive your Festive Spirit' competition entry boxes are located in the Wernhil stores and in designated areas within the centre. Entry boxes will be cleared weekly and all receipts will be recorded using an online data capture tool before being placed in the "Big Money Blower" for the final draw. By entering this competition, participants consent to receiving future promotional SMS communications from Wernhil. Entrants may opt out at any time by replying with "opt out" to any such message.
2. The "Big Money Blower," stationed at the Wernhil Pick n Pay atrium, will securely store all valid, captured receipts until the final draw. On the day of the draw, twelve (12) receipts will be randomly selected from the "Big Money Blower." The first seven (7) selected receipts will determine the finalists, with the remaining five (5) serving as backups in the event that any of the initial finalists are unavailable or do not pass the vetting process. The draw will be conducted on Thursday, 5 December 2024, between 13:00 and 14:00.
3. The draw will be recorded by a Legal Officer and the Master of Ceremonies will oversee the draw. A content creator will produce promotional content to generate excitement for the event.
4. BrandX Events will contact potential winners by telephone using the mobile numbers provided on the contestant's entry receipts, starting on 6 December 2024. This process will continue until seven (7) finalists are confirmed.
5. If a potential winner has given incorrect contact details, the Promoter reserves the right to select another winner in terms of the rules.
6. To successfully pass the vetting process, contestants must be Namibian citizens or residents, must be 18 years old, possess a valid driving licence and be available to attend the grand prize giveaway event at Wernhil on 14 December 2024, between 11:00 and 13:00, and not be in contravention of clause 2 of these Terms and Conditions.
7. Failure to respond to the organiser's contact attempts within two (2) business days will result in disqualification.

#### 5. Prize Breakdown

The total prize value is **N\$576,375.72**, divided into seven (7) prizes:

1. **1st Prize:** Toyota Hilux Single Cab 2.0 VVT-I, valued at **N\$346,448.82**.
2. **2nd Prize:** Toyota Vitz 1.0 XR MT, valued at **N\$199,926.90**.
3. **3rd Prize:** Shopping vouchers worth **N\$10,000.00**
4. **4th Prize:** Shopping vouchers worth **N\$8,000.00**

5. **5th Prize:** Shopping vouchers worth **N\$6,000.00**
6. **6th Prize:** Grocery vouchers worth **N\$4,000.00**
7. **7th Prize:** Shopping vouchers worth **N\$2,000.00**

## **6. Grand Prize Giveaway and Game Rules**

1. Prize Determination and Game Rules: The allocation of prizes for the seven (7) confirmed winners will be determined at the Wernhil Grand Prize Giveaway, scheduled for Saturday, 14 December 2024, using a "Minute to Win It" game mechanism.
2. Game Rules: Seven (7) finalists will compete in a series of six (6) "Minute to Win It" obstacle games.
3. All finalists are required to participate in each game to ensure full engagement throughout the event.
4. Points will be awarded based on each finalist's performance. The five (5) finalists with the lowest points will receive vouchers according to their rankings, with prizes allocated in ascending order based on points, where the lowest scorer receives the seventh prize, and the highest scorer receives the highest-value voucher prize.
5. The two (2) finalists with the highest points will have their scores reset to zero (0) and compete in a final obstacle game for the grand prize. The finalist with the fastest time will win the Toyota Hilux, while the runner-up will receive the Toyota Vitz.
6. In the event of a tie, an additional contingency game will be conducted to determine the final winner.
7. If a participant chooses not to participate in any of the games, they will be automatically disqualified, and the lowest value prize of the entire competition will be forfeited.
8. The competition will be overseen by a Legal Officer, to ensure compliance with the rules and fairness in the proceedings.

## **7. Prize Forfeiture and Attendance**

1. Attendance and Forfeiture of Prizes: In order to be eligible to partake in the final give away; after you have been selected as one of the seven (7) winners; it is needed for you to be present to partake in the game (competition) on Saturday, 14 December 2024; should you not be able to attend the game to partake you forfeit your place and another candidate will be selected from the draw. Exceptions will only be made for valid reasons, which are limited to medical emergencies or the death of an immediate family member. Such reasons must be substantiated with appropriate documentation, such as a medical certificate or death certificate.
2. Should a confirmed winner fail to attend the event without providing a valid reason, they will be disqualified from receiving any prize and their prize will be forfeited.

3. If a confirmed winner provides valid evidence of a medical emergency or an immediate family bereavement, they will be entitled to the lowest prize value of the "Minute to Win It" game. In cases where multiple winners are unable to attend due to valid reasons, a separate draw will be conducted by Wernhil Shopping Centre Management at a mutually agreed time and date, specifically to allocate the lowest prize values among those winners. This draw will take place in the presence of all affected individuals.
4. In the unfortunate event that a confirmed winner passes away before the prize-giving, their prize will not be transferable to a representative or any other individual; and will be forfeited
5. The number of obstacle games will be adjusted accordingly to reflect the number of remaining participants and any unallocated lower-value prizes will be forfeited.

## **8. Instant Prizes for Spectators**

During the prize-giving event on 14 December 2024, random spectators will receive instant prizes with a total value of **N\$2,500.00**. These will be handed out by the Master of Ceremonies, this will be based on the ceremonies discretion to spectators, no specific requirements are needed or necessary and will be done randomly

- One (1) Food Lovers voucher valued at N\$500.00
- One (1) Checkers Shopping voucher valued at N\$500.00
- One (1) Pick n Pay Shopping voucher valued at N\$500.00
- One (1) Dino's Fashion voucher valued at N\$500.00
- One (1) Dischem voucher valued at N\$500.00

## **9. Vehicle Giveaway and Insurance**

1. Insurance: No insurance will be provided with the vehicle. The winner will be solely responsible for obtaining and maintaining any necessary insurance coverage upon transfer of ownership.
2. Wernhil will insure the vehicle for a period of up to three (3) days following the prize-giving event, after which the responsibility for securing insurance will pass to the winner. This interim coverage is provided to allow the winner sufficient time to arrange their own insurance. Wernhil shall not be liable for any claims, damages, or liabilities arising after this period.
3. Vehicle Registration and Licensing: All costs associated with the vehicle's registration and licensing will be covered by the car dealership. The winner will not be responsible for any transfer fees, registration fees, or licensing costs related to the vehicle's ownership.
4. The winner must meet the necessary legal requirements for vehicle registration, including but not limited to providing a valid driver's license and an original certified

copy of their ID, a valid P.O. Box number and a physical residential address. Failure to meet these requirements may result in forfeiture of the prize.

5. Vehicle Condition and Warranty: Both vehicles (the Toyota Hilux Single Cab and Toyota Vitz) will be handed over in new condition including the respective warranties offered by the car dealership.
6. Handover Process: The official handover of the vehicles will take place during the Wernhil Grand Prize Giveaway on Saturday, the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2024, following the completion of the final draw and the verification of the winners. The winners will be announced and celebrated at the event; should a winner not wish to have their details disclosed, they have the right to state such.
7. Both vehicles will remain displayed at the Wernhil Pick n Pay atrium on 14 and 16 December 2024. Indongo Toyota will retrieve the vehicles on 16 December 2024, at which time the winners must meet with Indongo Toyota representatives at the Indongo Toyota premises in Windhoek to complete the required vehicle registration processes for the final handover.
8. Wernhil may photograph and record live content during the winner announcements for promotional purposes, however, should a winner not wish to have their details disclosed, they have the right to state such and such imaging/details will be blurred out.
9. The handover of the vehicle is considered final and Wernhil and its sponsors assume no further obligations beyond those outlined in the manufacturer's warranty and service plans. The winner assumes full responsibility for the vehicle upon transfer of ownership.

## 10. Spin the Wheel Competition

### 1. Eligibility and Participation

- a. During the "Drive Your Festive Spirit" campaign, Wernhil will host a Spin the Wheel competition activation on five (5) selected Saturdays and give out shopping vouchers from selected Wernhil stores.
- b. To participate, shoppers must spend a minimum of **N\$150.00** or more at any store in Wernhil on the day of the competition.
- c. The spin the wheel activation has no age restriction.
- d. Participants must present their valid purchase receipt to the Wernhil Promoter stationed at the Spin the Wheel stand, located in front of selected Wernhil stores, to confirm eligibility for the competition on the designated activation day.
- e. Each participant is allowed one spin per purchase. Upon completion of the spin, the receipt will be stamped to indicate redemption and participants must sign an indemnity form and winner acknowledgment sheet to confirm receipt of any prize.
- f. Participants can only win once per day but may play again the following day if new receipt can be provided.

- g. Once the prizes in a specific category have been depleted, that category will be marked with a sticker indicating 'oops.' This designation will remain until all prizes across all categories for the day have been claimed.

## **2. Activation Dates and Prizes**

The competition will run on the following activation dates, offering **N\$7,000.00** worth of prizes per day, for a total prize pool of **N\$35,000.00** over five weeks:

- o Week 2: 26 October 2024
- o Week 3: 9 November 2024
- o Week 4: 23 November 2024
- o Week 5: 30 November 2024

## **3. Weekly Prize Breakdown:**

The Spin the Wheel will be divided into seven (7) sections, as outlined below:

1. Mystery prizes from selected Wernhil stores
2. Grocery voucher from selected Wernhil stores
3. Lunch voucher from selected Wernhil stores
4. Clothing voucher from selected Wernhil stores
5. Stationery voucher from selected Wernhil stores
6. Electronics voucher from selected Wernhil stores
7. Oops: No prize awarded. The participant may try again with a new, valid receipt.

## **4. Prize Allocation and Redemption**

- a. Once the allocated prizes for a specific competition day are fully redeemed, the Spin the Wheel activity will be halted for that day and resumed on the following activation date.
- b. If any prizes remain unclaimed on a given competition day, those prizes will automatically roll over to the next scheduled competition date.
- c. Should any prizes remain unclaimed after the final activation on 30 November 2024, they will be distributed at random by the Master of Ceremonies at his or her own discretion during the Grand Prize Giveaway on Saturday, 14 December 2024.

## **11. General Terms and Conditions**

1. The Promoter will not be liable for any transport costs incurred by the finalists to attend the event and/or collect the prize.
2. Prizes cannot be exchanged for cash and vouchers can only be used at Wernhil stores. It is the winner's responsibility to take note of any expiry dates or terms and conditions displayed on the voucher(s).
3. The Promoter reserves the right to change or terminate the competition without notice if circumstances beyond their control arise.

4. The Promoter, its agents and associated companies will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from participation in the competition.
5. Participation constitutes acceptance of the rules and terms outlined here.
6. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding disputes.
7. The Promoter may refuse to award prizes if irregularities or fraudulent activities are detected.
